PROFESSOR YUNHUA FENG moved to the United States from China in 1990, having taught mathematics for 26 years. While in China, she served as the Coordinator/Research Fellow of High School Mathematics Teaching and Improvement for ten years. Prior to coming to OSSM, Prof. Y. Feng worked with the Study of Mathematically Precocious Youth (SMPY) at Johns Hopkins University and coached talented students for the MATHCOUNTS Competition and the American High School Mathematics Examination (AHSME). Prof. Y. Feng has been with OSSM since 1994. She has taught Precalculus, Calculus, Multivariate Calculus, Number Theory, and Special Advanced Problems. She lives at the OSSM dormitory with her husband, OSSM math professor Chengde Feng, and is responsible for supervising various math contests and preparing students for AP Calculus examinations at OSSM.
