Dr. Rahman has taught General and Organic Chemistry at OSSM for 13 years. He received his M.S. degree in Organic Chemistry from Brandeis University and his Ph.D. in Organometallic Chemistry from The Australian National University. Since coaching the Chemistry Olympiad at OSSM he has sent 10 students to the National Olympiad Team. Those teams went on to win the Gold Medal in 2002, Silver in 2001 and the Bronze in 2000 and 2002 at the International Chemistry Olympiad. He has coached OSSM students for the TEAM+5 competitions since 2000. They have secured State Championships every year since that time. In addition, the Junior Varsity team ranked 1st and the Varsity 3rd in the nation in 2005.
