OSSM MISSION

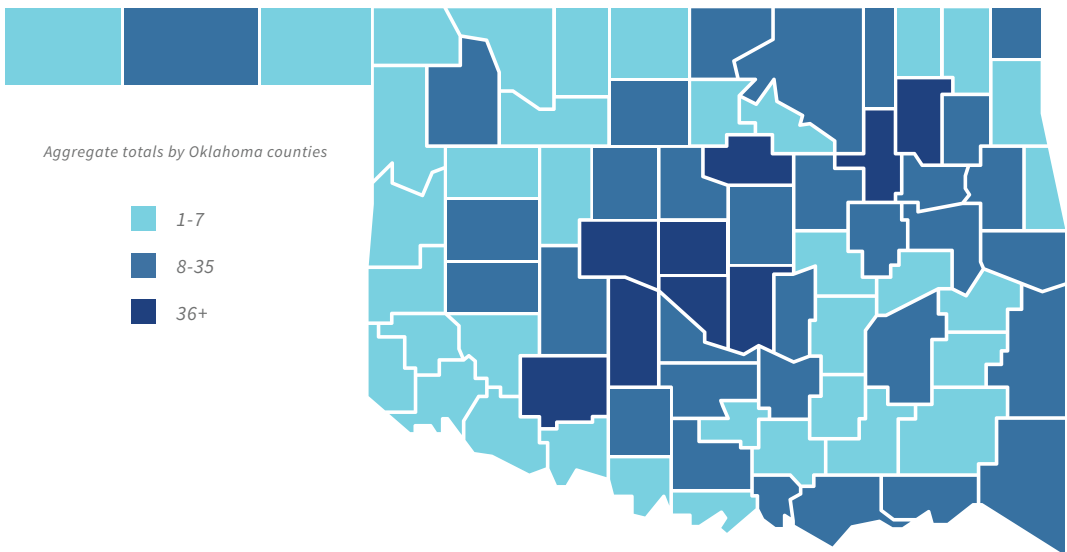
The mission of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics is to:

RESIDENTIAL

Immersion model supports students' academics

OSSM is a state funded, two-year **residential high school** for Oklahoma juniors and seniors with ability and interest in science and math. Nationally recognized as a top performing high school, OSSM challenges students *far* beyond the traditional high school model. Everything at OSSM supports students' academics—from the school's residential immersion model, **college-level curriculum**, and largely doctoral-level teaching faculty (70%) to required evening study halls staffed with faculty, peer support, and limited cell phones and personal internet. Students leap forward in their academic progress, with many OSSM graduates receiving numerous credits for their OSSM classes at their chosen institutions of higher learning.



REGIONAL

Rural students find advanced classes at OSSM Regional Centers

In addition, OSSM operates seven Regional Centers in rural areas across the state located in partnering Career Techs, providing students with advanced courses, typically calculus and calculus-based physics, near their homes. Students from as many as 15-20 sending schools around an OSSM Regional Center can attend the OSSM program half of each school day during their junior or senior year. They can take AP calculus, physics, and other courses not available at their traditional high schools from highly-prepared OSSM instructors.

Bringing advanced education to all students

OSSM also operates a **Virtual Regional Center** where instruction in calculus and calculus-based physics is delivered online to students across the state, AND regular labs are conducted in face-to-face visits from their OSSM instructor.

During the school year, students from across Oklahoma participate in OSSM's annual **Middle School Math Contest**. OSSM also engages students statewide through **summer program** offerings:

- Middle School Math & Science (one-day) Workshops sponsored by Williams Companies
- GE Summer STEM Academy – A week-long STEM camp for high school students sponsored by the GE Foundation through the Oklahoma Center for Advancement of Science and Technology (OCAST)
- The OSSM Summer Academy – A fee-based week-long STEM camp for high school students

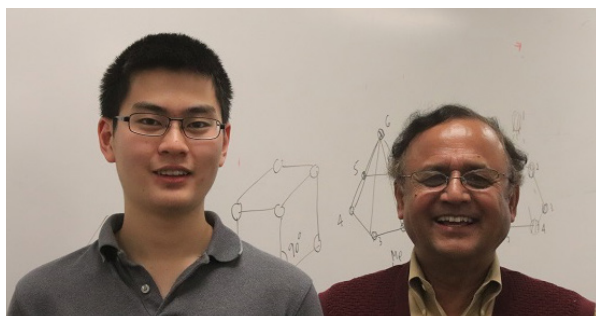

Unprecedented Discoveries

GEORGE WANG | OSSM CLASS OF 2018 (*Jenks H.S., Tulsa*)

George Wang, 18 years old and freshly graduated from Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics this past May, recently made an unprecedented discovery about carbon atoms.

George’s findings came after his chemistry professor challenged the class. Carbon’s standard four bonds have been taught in chemistry class for years; however, new research was published in 2016 asserting that carbon can actually make six chemical bonds. OSSM chemistry professor, Dr. A.K. Fazlur Rahman, asked his students if carbon could bond with more than six atoms.

George Wang took that challenge. After first verifying the work of the European researcher who published the 2016 paper, he then worked on calculations which proved mathematically that carbon could indeed make a seventh bond previously thought impossible. Wang and Rahman worked with University of Oklahoma chemist Dr. Bin Wang (no relation) to verify George’s work, and George’s research was recently published in a peer-reviewed international chemistry journal.

“George Wang’s discovery is remarkable,” Dr. Rahman said, “not only because it was made by a high school senior, but that it was made by a student in a state that consistently ranks among the lowest in education.”

George is interested in studying chemistry, math, physics, and computer science in college. Who knows what he will discover next!

Dr. Dennis helped create a scoring system for blunt trauma induced ventral hernias which has since been adopted as the standard worldwide, created a new practice model leading to record-breaking productivity, founded one independent and novel hospital medicine company focused on physician and patient satisfaction, and founded another medical device company stemming from his patented invention of a safety release valve that prevents medical tubing from being inadvertently dislodged from patients. That company, Linear Medical Services, was selected as one of the top 10 medical technology startups in the world.

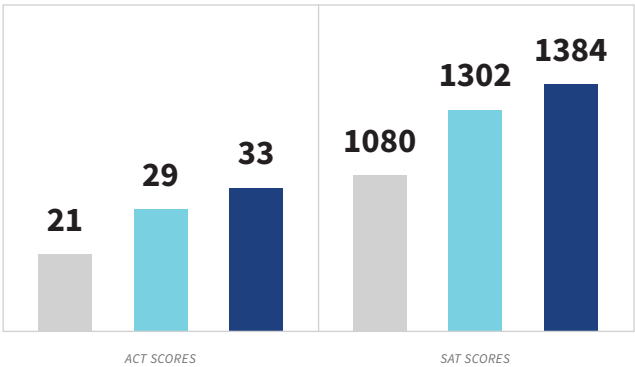

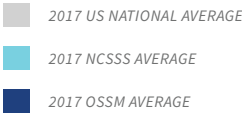
OSSM students leap forward in their academic progress, and graduates often receive numerous credits for their OSSM classes at chosen institutions of higher learning.

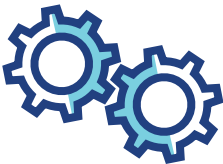
FURTHER EDUCATION

My wife Catherine and I decided to leave a portion of our estate to OSSM because we recognize the value that can come from an educated society. We see the opportunity this school offers to many talented students that could otherwise be out of their reach. For us it is a small way to give back to the community, and we are thankful to be able to do it.

I grew up in Port Arthur Texas with my twin brother and two younger brothers and, in 1966, completed my Mechanical Engineering degree at Lamar University. After four years with Westinghouse Electric, I joined OG&E as a Mechanical Engineer in Power Plant. While at OG&E, I earned a master's degree in business and, in 1994, was appointed Vice President of Power Supply, assuming responsibility for all of OG&E's power plants, engineering, and fuel supply.

In 2000, I was asked to serve on the Governing Board of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics and was immediately impressed by the faculty and curriculum the school offered its students. I have served on the board since then.

OSSM president Dr. Wang regularly asks students to join board meetings to share about their background, what they hope to achieve, and what brought them to OSSM. Many come from small schools across the state where math, chemistry, and physics offerings are limited. Many remark they never had to study very hard before, but this quickly changed at OSSM because much is expected. These same students tell us they are much better prepared to be successful at the university level due to the rigorous OSSM environment. To me, this is one of the great things the school does for bright students.

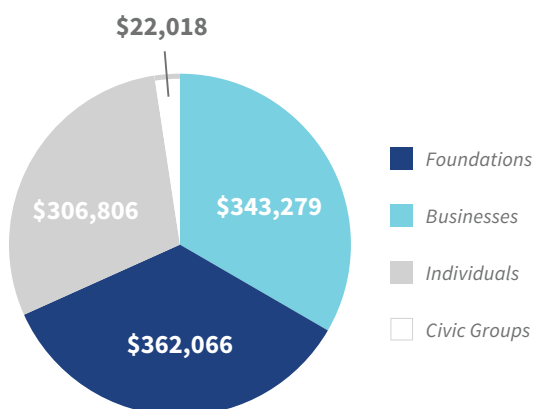

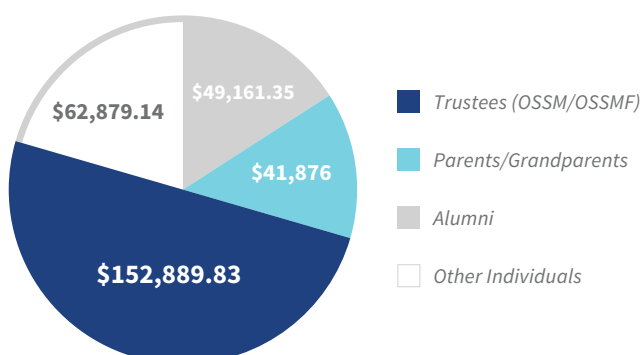
